



**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROVISION OF SOFTWARE  
DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO THE BOTSWANA INSTITUTE FOR  
TECHNOLOGY RESEARCH AND INNOVATION – START-UP  
SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT COMPANIES**

## **1. Background**

Botswana Institute for Technology Research and Innovation (BITRI) was established in 2012 as a Government of the Republic of Botswana company limited by guarantee, to conduct needs-based research and development in focused areas, in accordance with national priorities. BITRI is established under the Ministry of Tertiary Education, Research, Science and Technology (MOTE), with a Mandate to identify, develop and/or adapt appropriate technology solutions that provide sustainable innovative solutions through co-creation and collaboration in line with national priorities and needs of Botswana.

BITRI, under its Technologies Department and the Information Systems Technologies (IST) Division, is desirous of engaging a group of Citizen-owned Software Development Start-up Companies to be appointed as and when need arises, for the provision of Software Development Services for a period not exceeding two (2) years. The selected companies will be expected to undergo induction training on key BITRI software technologies stack, software development processes, security and quality criteria. In addition, the companies will be expected to, when assigned work, attach government-sponsored interns/graduates with ICT and related qualifications for the purpose of exposing them to practical skills in software development processes.

Citizen-owned Software Development Start-up Companies are invited to submit proposals to be considered for the provision of Software Development Services to BITRI. After the normal evaluation process, all short-listed companies will be included on the list of Software Development service providers to BITRI. Inclusion of a company in the list is on a non-exclusive basis. BITRI may from time to time invite any company included in the said list to provide Software Development services as desired. At its own discretion, BITRI may instruct a company not included in the list for the provision of Software Development services as BITRI might deem appropriate or beneficial.

## **2. Eligibility Criteria**

2.1 In order for a company to be eligible for evaluation and further consideration for selection, it must:

- i) be citizen-owned Botswana registered company

- ii) be registered with Public Procurement and Asset Disposal Board (PPADB) in the following categories:

**Code 120: ICT Systems and Management Services**

**Sub code 01: Systems Development Services and Maintenance**

- iii) satisfy Government of Botswana Income and VAT Tax provisions
- iv) provide schedule of fees for Junior Software Developer, Software Developer and Senior Developer expressed in hourly rates and stated in Botswana Pula
- v) provide Curriculum Vitae of all key personnel (as in iv) above) complete with educational/professional certificates
- vi) provide a complete company profile
- vii) provide software quality assurance/control plan
- viii) provide software security assurance plan
- ix) provide company software development stack and methodologies

**3. Disclaimer**

BITRI shall not be responsible for any cost incurred by any company in the preparation or submission of any proposal or to procure or contract for any services. Selection does not confer any exclusivity rights nor guarantee that the company will receive business from BITRI.

BITRI reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals, to revise the Expression of Interest, to request one or more re-submissions or clarification from one or more companies or to cancel the Expression of Interest.

**4. Evaluation**

BITRI Shall use the Quality Based Selection (QBS) evaluation method to assess submissions.
